No. 40195 working the daily Llandudno Junction T30 trip passes signal 114 on the outskirts of Holyhead. The flat wagons immediately behind the fuel tank are returning empty having been used to move steel to Holyhead docks for export to Ireland on behalf of Stockton Haulage Ltd.



(Right) Plate 72 *Holyhead, 16th February 1977*
No. 40137 seen climbing out of Holyhead on a Willesden bound Freightliner. This particular member of the Class had the distinction of being the first to visit the Rhymney Valley line, being noted at Caerphilly with a tank train originating from Ellesmere Port on 9th September 1978. Unofficially named '*Trojan*', she was to end her days as a Longsight based locomotive in early January 1981.
